Automated Side Loader (ASL) Curbside Recycling Driver

Western Washtenaw Recycling Authority is accepting applications for a full-time Driver position at our Materials Recovery Facility (MRF). An employee in this position will be running curbside recycling routes in an Automated Side Loader (ASL), along with various tasks assigned by the manager. This employee will assist in weekly recycling collection in the City of Chelsea along with the Townships of Bridgewater, Dexter, Lima, Lyndon, and Manchester. This employee should hold a valid Michigan Commercial Driver's License (Group A) preferred along with a medical card. If needed, the WWRA will provide an opportunity for the employee to obtain their CDL license. Drug and alcohol testing is a required part of the hiring process and maintaining your position at the WWRA.

Primary Responsibilities

- Run curbside recycling routes in an Automated Side Loader (ASL)
- Back up and dump recyclable material on the MRF floor
- Maneuver truck into and around residential and commercial areas
- Perform pre and post trip mechanical inspections of the ASL truck
- Adhere to DOT, OSHA, FMCSA, and EPA regulations and standards.
- Perform other driving and facility tasks, as assigned by the Facility Manager

Qualifications and Experience

- High school diploma or GED preferred
- Michigan Commercial Driver's License (CDL) class A or B
- Medical Examiner's Certificate (MEC) for Commercial Drivers
- Must be 18 years of age or older to obtain your CDL
- 1-2 years of CDL experience preferred
- Must be able to drive and sit for long periods of time
- Must be able to lift, push, pull, or carry objects up to 50 pounds
- Must be able to safely drive the truck and operate the equipment
- Must have knowledge of the truck and its components and the basic maintenance requirements for safe operation
- Ability to read, write, and comprehend route maps
- Must pass a drug and alcohol test for both hiring and continued employment
